Outside the Michelle Obama rally at Whalen Gymnasium at Fort Lewis College I was handing out political fliers to people who were standing in line waiting to get into the event. I was told to leave the area where I was lawfully handing out political fliers in compliance with campus policy. Both Trish Hutchens and Dave Peterson told me to leave. As such, their actions amount to criminal harassment (statute 18-9-111) #4(b)(III).

Furthermore, Hutchens and Peterson were working under the authority of Durango Police Department Police Chief Jim Spratten, according to Fort Lewis College Police Chief Arnold Trujillo.

The written response to this complaint, therefore, should be finalized by Chief Spratten.

Additionally, violating my right to freedom of speech is a civil offense that's punishable in a court of law.

Please remove these criminals from your police force immediately.

I hereby state that the information provided by me in this complaint is true and correct. I understand that if investigation reveals that I have knowingly provided false or misleading information, I may be subject to criminal charges under Municipal Code 17-32 or C.R.S. 18-8-111.
